



Advanced Diploma of Health Science (Aesthetics) Information for: Registered, Endorsed Enrolled Nurses

The Gold Coast Training Academy is now offering an accredited course in Advanced Aesthetic Therapies leading to a qualification as an Aesthetic Therapist. This course was written in response to the many requests by nurses for such a course.

The Advanced Diploma of Health Science (Aesthetics) is a very skin specific course incorporating both theory and practical units. It provides a registered or endorsed enrolled nurse formal qualifications in performing cosmetic injections, dermal filling procedures, the application of a range of chemical peels, the use of electrical equipment such as I.P.L, low intensity lasers, laser hair removal systems, oxygen therapies, advanced micro-dermabrasion and lymphatic drainage for post operative surgery. This qualification will also provide an in-depth knowledge of pre and post operative procedures including nutritional support programs, and the opportunity for electives such as micro-pigmentation techniques to perform remedial cosmetic tattooing.

One of the great advantages in completing this course is that we have secured professional indemnity insurance at an attractive premium for a qualified nurse (with the above mentioned credentials). This will mean that a nurse with the Advanced Diploma of Health Science (Aesthetics) certification can be independently insured from the doctor with which they may have been working.

However, it is also possible to just complete the units “Perform cosmetic injections and dermal filling procedures”, and co-requisites “Skin Science” and “Skin Biology” to obtain this indemnity insurance. This course is conducted by our Medical Director.

As the delivery of this course is part time, it allows you to continue working. Easy payment plans are available, and in some cases students may be able to apply for a N.A.B Loan which offers a deferred payment scheme.

The Advanced Aesthetics course has an excellent vocational outcome for nurses who wish to move away from the traditional areas of nursing and into the rapidly growing area of anti-aging therapies.
